

Call your local AJC Business Services Representative to:

- Post <u>Job Openings</u> on www.JOBS4TN.gov, a free online database where employers can manage job listings, search for candidates and review the résumés of qualified candidates.
- Host <u>Job Fairs/Hiring Events</u> at the AJC, your facility, or another venue. Join other employers or schedule a private event to recruit and screen prospective employees.
- Receive <u>Screened Applicant Referrals</u> based on experience, education, and skill requirements.
- Find *Target Populations*, such as veterans, who are interested in working for your company.
- Use AJC <u>Social Media</u> to promote job openings and company events. Find us on Facebook @NWTNjobs, follow us on Twitter @nwtnjobs, or visit our website www.nwtnjobs.org
- Schedule the <u>Mobile AJC</u> to set-up at your company with a computer lab, internet access, and knowledgeable staff for an on-site recruitment and assessment. Self book at www.CareerCoach.Info@tn.gov

• Learn about <u>FastTrack Job Training Assistance Program</u> for new or expanding industry, including reimbursable grants for infrastructure development, job training, and other expenses.

- Receive referrals for <u>On-the-Job Training</u> for eligible new hires with little or no experience. Employers may be reimbursed up to 50% for completion of a short training period.
- Apply for *Incumbent Worker Training Grants* to upgrade skills of existing, full-time employees.
- Explore how <u>Apprenticeships Programs</u> can provide both on-the-job and classroom training to Employers to prepare individuals to become active, entry-level workers by the end of the program
- Provide a <u>Work Experience</u> opportunity for eligible young adults and other individuals with little to
 no work experience to prove themselves a valuable employees before you hire them. Wages and
 workmen's compensation paid by the AJC.
- Earn <u>Work Opportunity Tax Credits</u> when hiring certain target groups of job seekers who face employment barriers.

Rapid Response

- Get assistance with <u>Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)</u> compliance, including training on hiring and interviewing candidates, sensitivity/disability awareness training, and ADA facility surveys.
- Help your employees earn their *High School Equivalency Diploma* through tutoring assistance.
- Connect employees with <u>TN Reconnect</u> advisors to learn about tuition free post secondary education and connect employers with institutions offering customized training.
- Secure free <u>Federal Bonding</u> for the first 6 months of employment for "at-risk" job seekers.
- Find <u>Labor Market Information</u> on www.JOBS4TN.GOV or request "specialized" data as needed.
- Help employees facing lay-off with <u>Rapid Response Services</u> by providing information about unemployment insurance, retraining, job opportunities, entrepreneurial, and other services.
